Celebrating the Feast of Trumpets & the Day of Atonement

Part I - Feast of Trumpets (Rosh Hashanah)

Lev 23:23-25: "Again the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ²⁴Say to the children of Israel, 'On the first day of the seventh month (month of **Ethanim** - Sept 18th 2025), you shall observe a day of solemn sabbatical rest, a memorial day announced by the blowing of trumpets, a holy convocation. 25 You shall not do any laborious work, but you shall present an offering by fire to the LORD." (Amplified Bible) From the first day of Trumpets to the Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur), there are a total of ten days. These ten days became known as the "Ten Days of Awe", which were days Israel was called to a time of solemnity and self-examination with repentance.

Hearing the blowing of the trumpet during these ten days, Israel was to remember **who they were** and **the special relationship** that they had with *YAH*, who called them to be a holy, set apart people. They were to recall how they individually had walked and lived before *YAH* for the past year and **repent of all sins they had committed**. They are to

become spiritually ready for the coming of the most holy day of the Jewish year – the **Day of Atonement**, which we will discuss in **Part II** of this **Short Lesson**.

This period of time was very important for Israel, as a large percentage of them walked contrary to the leading of Moses and to YAH's laws during the year. Throughout their history, YAH was constantly calling them back from their wicket ways and sinning against him through his prophets. In these last days we are "trumpeting" the gospel for Israel to return to YAH.

As stated in several of our earlier *SL*s about the feast days, **Trumpets** was also looking forward to a time and day when *YAH* will fulfill this and the last two feast days. The first four were fulfilled while *Yahushua* was on earth. But the last three have not been fulfilled yet. We are looking for *YAH*, in his own timing, to allow *Yahushua* to fulfill these three as well. But until then, we are to continue to memorialize them until the actual fulfillment is accomplished.





Blowing the Trumpet - Today Preaching the Gospel

How to prepare and observe the Feast of Trumpets:

¹On the first day of the blowing of the trumpet, we are told to have a Holy Convocation (Gathering) of the Saints to exalt us to participate in this period of soul-searching and repentance. ²Perform no servile work on the first day, which would prevent us from attending the Holy Gathering. ³For the ten days leading up to the Day of Atonement, live in a state of personal reflection, prayer, and repentance. A returning to our calling to "be holy" as our YAH is holy, in anticipation of our sins being permanently removed from us. May this be the year!!! (See Part II of this lesson)
