

THE CHRISTIAN CHURCH'S ERROR WITH GOOD FRIDAY & RESURRECTION SUNDAY

Crucified



Mat 12:40 - Jesus said the only sign that adulterous generation would be given was the sign of the prophet Jonas: "As Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth." In an attempt to get Judaism out of Christianity, the church chose to ignore that the Jews had other holy days they called High Sabbaths, associated with their feast days. These High Sabbaths may or may not fall on . . .

In the Tomb – How Long?



NOTE: The Jewish calendar has the same date and days every year – there are no rolling-dates, as with the Gregorian calendar

the weekly Sabbath Day, Saturday. At the time of the crucifixion, Jesus had just celebrated the "Passover" with his disciples which started on Tuesday at sunset. He was crucified exactly on Passover day, which ended at sundown on Wednesday. The next day (Thursday) was the High Holy Sabbath of Unleavened Bread, which was to start at sundown on Wednesday evening. So, the rush to get him off the cross and into the tomb was because it had to be done before start of the High Holy Sabbath of Unleavened Bread, starting at sundown...

He is Risen, as He Said!



Wednesday. So, they got him buried on Wednesday evening before sunset. That's how you get 3 nights in the tomb (Wed-Thur-Frinights). And the 3 days (Thur-Fri-Sat). He rose EARLY Sunday morning before day. The Jewish day starts at sunset of the previous day, so he could have risen anytime after sunset on Saturday evening and sunrise Sunday morning. So, no matter how you try, you can't get 3 days & 3 nights from Good Friday evening to Sunday morning. At best, you get 2 nights and 1½ days.
