When Service Becomes Devoid of Devotion The One Necessary Thing

Luke 10:38-42

1. Marhta - worried about the carnal things. She was taking commendable care of her guest, as a good hostess is expected to do:

- Making things comfortable for Jesus, preparing food etc.
- She was totally absorbed in doing things for Jesus, but was at the same time neglecting him
- Had her service become "self-serving"? Was it just making her feel good about what she was <u>doing for Jesus</u>.
- She felt that she was carrying the whole load of hosting alone.
- She requested of Jesus that he tell her sister Mary to come and help her
- Poor Martha was fretful, troubled, disturbed, distracted, and divided by her cares

2. Mary was sitting at Jesus' feet and heard his words:

- She honored and pleased him where she was, and doing what she was doing
- She received his word into her heart
- She had wisdom to choose the good part
- What she got could never be taken from her

3. The one needful thing - to hear his word:

- Godliness units the heart that the world has divided
- The many things she worried about were needless, while the one thing she neglected was needful
- Life is made up of parts godliness is the good part and the only part that will go with us into another world

4. Evidently Jesus was not just doing "chit-chat" or making small-talk but speaking words of life to Mary. What he was serving was of much greater value than what Martha was trying to prepare to serve.

5. *Psalms 27:4* David would have loved to have had the opportunity that Mary and Martha had to sit at Jesus' feet:

• "One thing have I desired of the Lord, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in his temple."

6. Philippians 3:13-14:

- "Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended; but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,
- "I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus
- "Let us therefore, as many as be perfect, be thus minded: and if in any thing ye be otherwise minded, God shall reveal even this unto you."
