What is in the Covenants YAH Made with Israel?

¹Foundational Abrahamic Covenant

Subject: Descendants & Land – *Unconditional*

Sign: *Circumcision*



Gen 12:1- – “Now the LORD said to Abram, “Go from your country and your kindred and your father’s house to the land that I will show you. ²And **I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. ³I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed. ⁴So Abram went, as the LORD had told him... He was 75 years old when he**

departed Haran.” Then in verse 7 the LORD said to Abram – “**To your offspring I will give this land.**” Abram had traveled to Canaan at this time.

In **Chapter 12:4-7** YAH tells Abram after Lot had separated from him – “Lift up your eyes and look from the place where you are, northward and southward and eastward and westward, ⁵**for all the land that you see I will give to you and to your offspring forever. ⁶I will make your offspring as the dust of the earth,** so that if one can count the dust of the earth, your offspring also can be counted. ⁷Arise, walk through the length and the breadth of the land, for I will give it to you.”

This is the foundational covenant on which all the rest of the covenants YAH made with the nation of Israel stand.

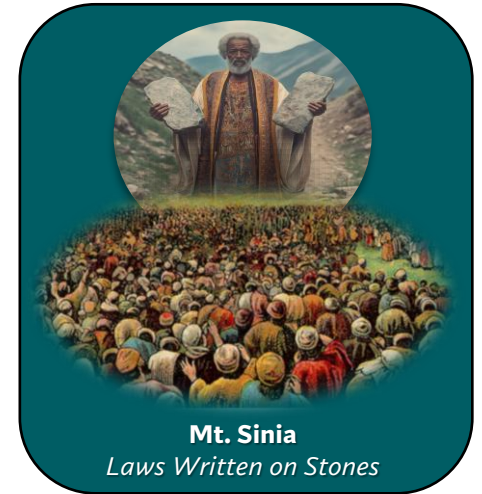
²Mosaic Laws for Living in the Promised Land

Subject: Palestinian Land Covenant - *Conditional*

Sign: *The Sabbath*

Ex 20:1-17 - YAH gives Israel the laws of the **Ten Commandments** as a summary of the laws they must keep in order to maintain the relationship he first established with Abram, the chosen leader of the covenant people of Israel. These ten are **followed by many more detailed instructions (603 laws)** on how Israel is to live with each other and with the peoples of the land in which YAH will give them, in **Exodus Chapters 19 – 24.**

Then YAH summarizes this Land Covenant with Israel in **Deut. Chapter 30.** Here is what YAH tells Israel clearly: ¹¹For this commandment that I command you today **is not too hard for you, neither is it far off. ¹⁵See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil. ¹⁶If you obey the commandments of the LORD your Elohim that I command you today,**



by loving YAH your Elohim, by walking in his ways, and by keeping his commandments and his statutes and his rules, **then** you shall live and multiply, and YAH, your Elohim will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it. ¹⁷**But** if your heart turns away, and you will not hear, but are drawn away to worship other gods and serve them, ¹⁸**I declare to you today, that you shall surely perish.**”

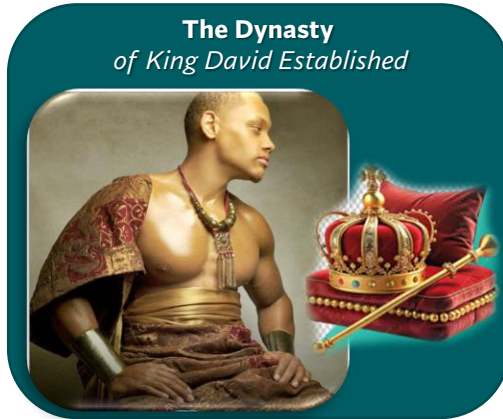

Subject: Establishing the Dynasty of David Forever – **Unconditional**

Sign: **Yahushua Ha'Massiah**



This is what **YAH** told Nathan the Prophet to tell David in **II Sam 7:8-16** – “Now therefore, thus shall you say to My servant David, ‘I took you from the sheepfold, from following the sheep, to be ruler over My people, over Israel. ⁹And I have been with you wherever you have gone, and have cut off all your enemies from before you, and have made you a great name, like the name of the great men who are on the earth. ¹¹... Also the LORD tells you that He will make

you a house (a royal dynasty). ¹²When your days are fulfilled and you rest with your fathers, **I will set up your seed after you, who will come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom.** ¹³He shall build a house for My name, and **I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.** ¹⁴I will be his Father, and he shall be My son. If he commits iniquity, I will chasten him with the rod of men and with the blows of the sons of men. ¹⁵**But My mercy shall not depart from him,** as I took it from Saul, whom I removed from before you. ¹⁶**And your house and your kingdom shall be established forever before you. Your throne shall be established forever.”**

The ultimate “son of David” is the Messiah – whose kingdom will have no end. A hereditary monarchy.

Subject: Israel a Royal Priesthood & Holy Nation - **Unconditional**
Sign: **Sinless Perfection (Laws written inside us – not on stones/paper)**



Jer 31:31-34 - “Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when **I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah** - ³²not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, **My covenant which they broke**, though I was a husband to them, says the LORD. ³³But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: **I will put My law in their mind, and write it on their hearts** (their inward parts); and I will be their Elohim, and **they shall be My people.** ³⁴No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, ‘Know the LORD,’ for **they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them**, says the LORD. For **I will forgive their**

iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more.” The 8th chapter of Hebrews explains how this last covenant is so much better than the first – ¹**A Better Sacrifice (Christ)** – ²**Better High Priest & Mediator (Christ)** – ³**Better Promises (Sinless Perfection, Immortality, Spiritual Bodies, Eternal Life, and the Inheritance of Christ).** At its completion, we will truly be as Paul said, **“Living Epistles”**.

Summary of the Four Covenants

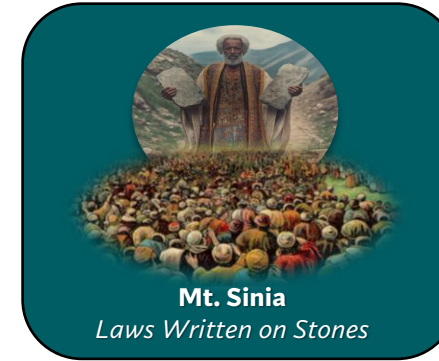


¹Foundational Abrahamic Covenant

Subject: Descendants & Land – **Unconditional**

Sign: **Circumcision**

- 1) **It is unconditional** - the effectiveness and blessings of this covenant *depends on YAH*
- 2) Make Abraham a **great nation**
- 3) Bless him and make his name great
- 4) **He will be a blessing** to others
- 5) **YAH** will **bless those that bless you**
- 6) **YAH** will **curse those that dishonor you**
- 7) In you **all families of the earth shall be blessed**
- 8) **All the land that you see** from the north, east, south, and west – **I will give to you and your offsprings forever**
- 9) I will make your offspring as the dust of the earth

Subject: Palestinian Land Covenant - **Conditional**

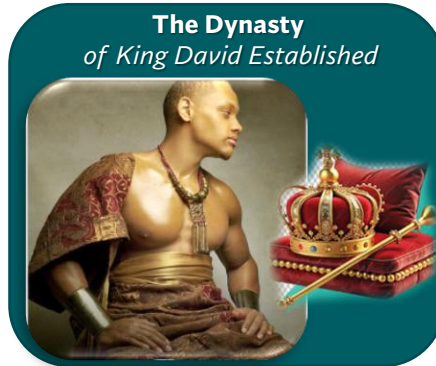
Sign: **The Sabbath**

- 1) **It is conditional** - *the effectiveness of this covenant depends on the actions of Israel*
- 2) Ten Commandments and other 603 laws given
- 3) The laws told Israel how to live with **YAH**, each other, and pagan nations around them
- 4) **YAH** said these laws were not too hard for them to keep
- 5) **They would result in life and blessings** - **if they kept them**
- 6) **They would result in death and evil** – **if they did not keep them**
- 7) **Obedience** = ¹Loving **YAH**, ²Walking in his ways, ³Keeping his commandments, statues, and rules. **Results** = **You shall live and multiple** AND **YAH will bless you in the land that you are going to possess**
- 8) **Disobedience** = ¹**Your heart turns away from YAH**, ²**You will not hear his words.** **Results** = ¹**Drawn to worship other gods**, ²**Will serve other gods**, ³**You shall surely perish and not remain in the land.**

Hear O Israel, our Elohim is one . . . Thy shall love Him with all your heart, mind, soul and all your might . . . Keep His precepts. (Deut. 6:4-5)

³Davidic Kingly Covenant

Subject: Establishing the Dynasty of David Forever – *Unconditional*

Sign: *Yahushua Ha'Massiah (Christ)*

- 1) **It is unconditional** – the effectiveness of this covenant depends on **YAH**
- 2) **YAH** took David from watching sheep – **to be King over Israel**
- 3) **YAH** stayed with him & **made him a great name on the earth**
- 4) **YAH** promised to establish the kingdom of his seed (Solomon) for ever and if he sinned, he would be chastened by the rod of men
- 5) **YAH** promised that **he would never take his mercy away from Solomon** as he did Saul
- 6) **YAH** promised David - **your house and your kingdom shall be established forever before you. Your throne shall be established forever.**
- 7) **Yahushua** - is the ultimate Son of David and his kingdom will have no end

Subject: Israel a Royal Priesthood & Holy Nation – *Unconditional*

Sign: *Sinless Perfection (Laws written inside us – not on stones/paper)*

- 1) **It is unconditional** – the effectiveness of this covenant depends on **YAH**
- 2) The new covenant, like the first one was made with Isarel and not the world - **“I will make a new covenant with the house of *Israel* and with the house of *Judah*”**
- 3) **This covenant is different from the first:**
 - 1) Christ is a better sacrifice than animal sacrifices, which cover temporarily
 - 2) Christ is a better High Priest & Mediator (sinless)
 - 3) **Made with Better Promises:**
 - **Sinless perfection** at our sealing in **Rev 7:1-8** (like Christ)
 - **Resurrection** from the dead (Like Christ – First Fruits)
 - **Immortality**, Spirit bodies (Like Christ)
 - **Spiritual powers** (Like Christ)
 - **Rule & reign with Christ in the millennium and eternity**
 - **Eternal life** (Like Christ)
 - **Enjoy the inheritance of the kingdom of YAH** (With Christ)
