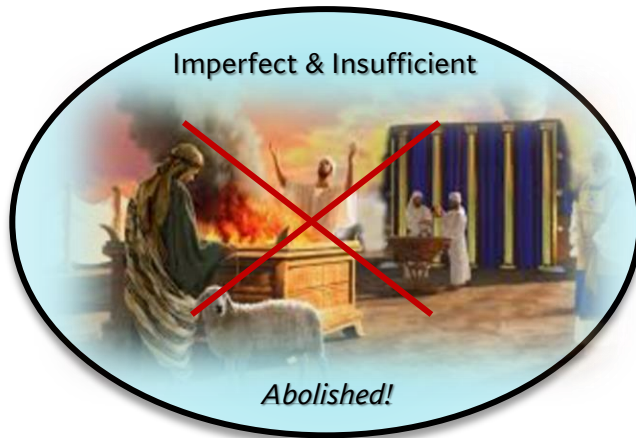


# WHAT ABOUT THE OTHER 600+ LAWS?

## The Levitical Priesthood



**Heb 10:9:** "He taketh away the first, that he may establish the second."

**Jewish scholars** – have counted a total of 613 commandments in the Torah (the first five books of the Bible written by Moses). These were all instructions and commandments given to Israel by *Yah*. Scholars have found that these laws and ordinances can be put into two major categories. First, there are **248 Positive Commands** (Thou shalt) and Secondly - **365 Negative** (Thou shalt not). Or, they can be further categorized into the **Ten Commandments** and those that deal with – 1) Levitical Laws, 2) Sacrificial Laws, 3) Laws for the Temple, 4) Family

Relations, 5) Dietary Laws, 6) Business 7) Times & Seasons, 8) Sexual Relations, 9) Criminal Laws, and 10) Punishment and Restitution just to name a few.

We know that all the laws that dealt with the **priesthood, animal sacrifices, and the temple** were done away with after the death and resurrection of Christ. This is said to be about 150 of the laws.

We know that the **Ten Commandments** were never revoked by *Yah* or *Yahusha*. So what about the other 453+ ordinances? Are we to still obey them?

## All the Law Hangs on These Two

1. Love *YAH* with all your heart, soul, mind & strength
2. Love your neighbor as yourself

The Other 453+ Laws

We know that **several are no longer applicable** to us today, just because we are not in the land of Israel, nor in the same living circumstances as Israel was at the time the laws were given. For example: **Not to sell a Hebrew servant as a slave**, or **Don't suffer anyone practicing witchcraft to live**, or **Have lepers to cry out "unclean"**. Here is what Yahusha said about the law: "*All the law & prophets hangs on the two of **Loving Yah, and your neighbor as yourself***" (Mat 22:40). If we faithfully keep those two, we automatically keep the others.
